Jered grew up and worked on his family farm in Woodbine. He loved his family, his friends and having a good time. He also had a special bond with a mule named Brownie. Hence, the formation of Harrison Mule Days in his hometown of Woodbine, as a celebration of his life!

We will be offering a \$1000 scholarship in his memory to assist with college or trade school expenses. Eligibility requirements are listed below. We thank you for taking the time to apply.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1 You, or an immediate family member, must have volunteered, participated in, or assisted in some way with the Harrison Mule Days event.
- 2 You must be accepted to or already attending a College, Vocational School or any other career-based learning program.
- 3 Applications must be complete.

Selection will be based on

- 1 Contents of application including essay responses and letters of recommendation.
- 2 Candidates may be interviewed. Please include a phone number to be reached.

This Scholarship may be awarded more than once to any candidate as long as eligibility requirements are met.

The decision of the selection committee will be final. The selection committee is an independent group that has no association with Harrison Mule Days. The Harrison family (and extensions thereof) will make no contributions to the decision making process nor will they influence the committee in any way.

The recipient will be recognized at the 2021 Harrison Mule Days event on Saturday, October 2nd, at approximately 8 pm.
